





Treasure Hunt.....

Give your children a list of things to find around the house or in the garden and then see how they get on!

Ideas include.....a banana, a leaf, a teddy or a book etc

For children who cope with the instructions being harder you could ask for.....something red, something to wear or an animal etc.

Objective:

Asking your child to repeat the words and location in which they found the items will develop communication and language skills. For families with multiple siblings, a system of teams can be operated to encourage bonding and teamwork.

Ask your child to write down on the treasure sheet the location they found the item – further developing language skills
